

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Village of Baddeck hereby gives notice that applications have been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the following works described herein and their sites and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, the Village of Baddeck has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>), under the **Registry #11742** or, under the **NPP File Number 2024-213471**, a description of the following work, its site location and plans for **Baddeck Boardwalk and Park** (walkway) located in Baddeck Harbour, approximately at 46°5'51"N, 60°44'57.98"W, in Baddeck, in Victoria County, Nova Scotia.
